Dr. Stieglitz has over 35 years of experience in developing organizations, building management teams, and streamlining business processes for corporations and government agencies. He has served in executive management positions in the U.S. Navy and in large and small corporations.

Dick earned a Ph.D. in Nuclear Engineering from Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute and received extensive leadership training as a U.S. naval officer refueling nuclear submarines during the Cold War. After leaving the Navy, he became Vice President of a software company and later was Consulting Director for a Fortune-100 aerospace firm.

In 1984, Dick founded RGS Associates Inc. to help executives in Federal agencies lead change. Since selling the company in 2006, he has devoted his efforts toward consulting, executive coaching, and writing. He books include: *Leadership Conversations – Challenging high potential managers to become great leaders* (2013), *Expensive Mistakes in Buying & Selling Companies* (2010), and *Taming the Dragons of Change in Business* (2008). He also publishes a monthly e-letter titled *The Change Challenge*; and speaks frequently at industry and government forums on the subjects of leadership, change, and building businesses.
